


Look for a big rock. No, really.

In the absence of street signs and an address, the best directions involve a dirt road and a really big rock. After passing the airport, take the second dirt road on the left and look for a highway rock marker that reads Kaunolu, an ancient village. Turn left and look for the gate on the right. There's no admission fee, but if you love cats, your tax-deductible donation will help us continue our rescue work and provide lifelong care.

We're open daily from 10 am to 3 pm and no appointment is needed. Bring a picnic and be ready to play and stay the day. We have cold soda, juice and water available for purchase. Know that you might have to stand on a makeshift box in the middle of a field to catch a cell phone signal.
